The Dordt University Wind Symphony from Sioux Center, Iowa, invites you to a concert at 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, March 11, at the Central Wisconsin Christian School Crusader Center in Waupun. This free concert is part of a spring tour with

performances scheduled in Iowa, Nebraska, South Dakota, and Wisconsin. Under the baton of Associate Professor and Director of Instrumental Activities Dr. Onsby C. Rose, the Wind Symphony will perform a wide variety of repertoire. Highlights of this concert is a new work commissioned by the Dordt Wind Symphony from Kansas composer Grace Baugher-Dunlap titled *Consider the Heavens*.
